Love of horses and fox hunting brought Mary to Southern Pines in 1952. She was a homemaker and owner/manager of Economy Farm.

Mary was an active member of the Moore County Hounds and she was involved in the organization of the Moore County Driving Club serving as President.

During the years of running Economy Farm Mary hosted many MidSouth Schooling Shows the revival of which this Benefit Show owes its existence.

As a member of the Moore County Driving Club Mary competed in driving shows on the local level and on the national level.
